- Reduced price tickets for family, friends and community members to the concert: \$21 adult tickets and \$6 student tickets to Classics and Pops, \$8 tickets for Family concerts, purchased at the Box Office, 885-5000, based on availability.
- A chance to meet the conductor and/or the soloists of the evening's concert, pending availability.
- Posters advertising the pre-concert performance for display in their school/community.

Prerequisites for Community Spotlights

- Directors and performers are required to stay for the Buffalo Philharmonic Concert.
- One chaperone for every fifteen students is required.
- All Community Spotlight performances are 30 minutes in length and begin 45-minutes prior to the Buffalo Philharmonic concert.
- All persons entering Kleinhans Music Hall must have a ticket.
- All performing ensembles must bring their own music stands and percussion equipment. All equipment must leave Kleinhans the end of the BPO concert.
